



Dear CKC Families,

We are looking forward to a wonderful summer camp this year at Main Street Elementary School. We care deeply about sharing a fun and meaningful experience with your children. This summer, will be very different from camps in the past, but we will still have lots of activities and variety throughout the day.

We are working hard getting the Main Street Campus ready for our summer campers. Our staff are coming back the week before camp for extra training to learn all the current health and safety protocols and to prepare all the on-site daily activities. We know that the last year has been a challenge for many families and children. We also know there will be a few glitches that we all will have to work through together, please be patient with our staff. Here are a few of the differences from CKC camps in the past:

- Please pack a healthy lunch for your child each day. Please note we will not be able to refrigerate or warm up any food items. We will have milk and water available for meal times. We will provide simple morning and afternoon snacks each day.
- **CKC is a NUT FREE camp.**
- Your child will have a bucket for all their belongings, as well as supplies. Everything needs to be taken home at the end of the day so we can sanitize the buckets except sunscreen and the baggie of supplies.
- Please send your child with sunscreen the first day of camp and label it with their name to keep in their bucket. Please apply sunscreen before sending your child to camp.
- All drop off and pick-ups will be curbside and require a health and temperature check of your. Parents and child should wear facemask when dropping off. Your child's belongings will be kept in his/her bucket all day. You will sign in and out each day.
- We will have one or two tables in the front of the school for drop off and pick up. We will have clearly labeled social distancing marks for you to wait on. Please adhere to social distancing during drop off and pickup. If we get too backlogged at pick-up or drop-off, we will assign windows of time for each family.
- CKC staff will be wearing labels for nametags or their CKC staff shirts.
- Please review the Covid-19 virus protocols on our website.
- Your child will be in a stable group of 15- 18 children with 2 staff. Staff will wear facemasks.
- Your child will need to wear a facemask at all times, except during meal times. We will have extra facemasks if a child needs one.

- Social distancing will be suggested, but we know the children are eager for interaction with their peers and our current licensing guidelines don't require it. We will spend much of our days and meals outside, weather permitting.
- Each child will be assigned a group and a classroom/MU that will be consistent throughout the camp session. Groups will not share indoor space/equipment.
- If your child becomes ill at camp, they must be picked up within 30 minutes and keep their mask on. They will be isolated until they are picked up.
- Our primary communication will be by email, including if a staff or child tests positive for COVID-19.
- We will not refund tuition for the first 2 weeks of any closure as required by the health department.

Your child's health and safety is our primary concern. CKC employs dedicated professionals with training and education in current protocols and policies in regards to COVID-19. All CKC sites are licensed by the State of California and we currently maintain a maximum 1:14 child to teacher ratio at all times based on requirements. Our summer staff are trained in CPR and First Aid. We are looking forward to having your child with us. Please feel free to contact us with any questions or concerns.
