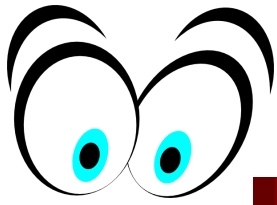

New Enrollment Information for Next School Year!!!

Congratulations! You are eligible for priority enrollment for your child(ren) currently enrolled in our CKC program. You are guaranteed enrollment for the 19/20 school year based on your child's (children's) schedule as of January 31, 2019.

PRIORITY ENROLLMENT DATES

- **Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at DeLaveaga CKC portables from 2:00-5:00pm ONLY for currently enrolled children. (NOTE: Payments accepted on this day are personal check or credit card on file only).**
- **Currently enrolled families and incoming TK/Kindergarten families may come to the office any time between 8:30am-3:30pm on Tuesday, March 17 or Wednesday, March 18 at the CKC Admin office in Capitola ONLY from 8:30am-3:30pm.**

WHAT TO BRING

- **Completed returning family enrollment packet (handed out at the site).**
- **Registration fee and first months tuition.**
