We have had many request for our playdough recipe so here it is!

Cooked Playdough

2 cups of flour

1 cup of salt

2 tablespoons of cream of tartar

Mix all dry ingredients together in a bowl. Mix together 2 cups of water, 2 tablespoons of vegetable oil and food color in a big pan. Heat liquid and stir in dry ingredients. Cook and stir over medium heat until dough forms a ball on the spoon and is slightly translucent. Turn onto flat surface and knead until smooth. Once completely cooled store in an airtight container.

- You can add essential oils or cinnamon to create scented playdough
